Thanks for purchasing the template and for supporting our work. Argus is our new fancy template. Responsive, clean and professional look with sleek design will satisfy all your needs. Argus have a width fixed layout. All parts are nested in divs which representing each menu item section. Considering that "Argus" is a single page template, html is rather robust, but it is divided into logical segments in order to make changes and maintenance easier. Popup Box Linking

Our theme is a single page template, but we separated popup content into external files. These are the following things that you should know

Link that point to external file which content do you want to display into popup need to have a class of "read-more", and also it's required to have an ID attribute added to that link.

Here's the example of HTML code which you can use to display content from news_1.html file.

```
<a class="read-more" id="news-1" href="popup/news_1.html"></a>
```

Actually, you can display popup in one more way, by clicking on the title of the post.

```
<h2 class="m-bottom-25 read-more">development of new lorem ipsum

Popup HTML Structure

All the content that you want to display into popup needs to be into the **article** tag with classes "**hidden**" and "**modal**".

Here is the code that we have used in our demo:

Slider Configuration

Here's the example of slider of your template.

Basically you have "ul" element with list of slides that you want to display, for example:

After you create appropriate HTML structure you will have to add this part of code in our main.js file:

```
$('#home-slides').carouFredSel({
responsive: true,
auto: false,
align: 'center',
height: 'variable',
scroll: 1,
next: '#home-next',
mousewheel: true,
swipe: {
onMouse: true,
onTouch: true
}, items: {
height: 'variable'
}
});
```

All sliders that are used in Argus template have similar settings.

You can notice that we used here ID of our UL tag as selector which represent slides holder, you will have to modify it to your own needs (replace it), and note that each html element need to have unique ID. Another thing that is important here is the div with class "carousel-nav"(sliders from services and about section), which contains hyperlinks that are used in purpose of slider navigation.

Portfolio gallery

Gallery of this section is driven by jquery.prettyPhoto.js plug-in. Thumbnails of the gallery are organized like list items of the unordered list with class "gallery". You can embed images, text and video files. Thumbnail images are located in "Argus/images/portfolio/thumbs/" folder and full sized images are located in "Argus/images/portfolio/originals" folder.

Here is the example of embedding image:

All list items are with class “item”. List item that you want to be in a specific category should have class of that category. Please, check examples above.

You can determine specific categories (red marked classes) in unordered list with class “filterOption”. Unordered list with class “filterOption”:

Javascript settings regarding to this section can be found in Argus/js/portfolio.js. There is an important thing you should be aware of. You will see prettyPhoto settings two times. If you make changes, do it in both settings.
